This item was postponed until further notice.
- 21/11K To consider the results from the Youth Provision survey at the Pump track event to establish current needs from the youth in the parish.
Councillor Coleman advised that the youth survey established there is a need for a Youth Provision in the parish. A room is available at the Sports Centre and the Council will discuss plans with Villages Together regarding potential funding. The Council have agreed in principle to adding the cost to the 2022-2023 budget if funding is not provided. The Youth Provision Working Group will continue sourcing information to present to the Council at the next meeting in December.
- 21/11L To consider using CIL finds to resurface the path to the Nature Reserve from the Sports Centre.
It was resolved to approve this in principle. Full approval from Puriton Playing Fields is required before quotes can be obtained.
- 21/11M To consider installing a new litter bin on hall road.
It was agreed that the clerk will write to the local businesses based at the Dunball roundabout to ask if they would pay for a litter bin or contribute toward the cost before a new bin is purchased, as the litter is from items purchased there.
- 21/11N Councillor Reports.
Councillor Langley advised that the Sports Centre could apply for funding from Sport England if it was listed as a strategic facility for the Polden Hills. Councillor Healey will propose this with Sedgemoor District Council and Somerset County Council and report back. Draft documents for the Local Development Order is available online and at the 37 Club for members of the public to view during of the consultation process.
Councillor Coleman advised the Puriton Sports Centre that the youth questionnaire results asked for additional goal nets. Councillor Fletcher will source some quotes for nets to apply for a grant from the Parish Council.
Councillor V Crow advised of a Charity in Bridgwater that can provide support on youth mental health and will provide details to the clerk.
Councillor B Crow has spoken to Highways at Somerset County Council regarding obsolete, covered and new road signage to warn of the new roundabout/road layout. He also plans to meet a member from the highways team in the village to discuss additional signage.
